Minutes for March 18, 2012

Anne Tinker called the March meeting of the Southern Tier Orchid Society to order at approximately 2:15 P.M. There was no treasurer's report today because our treasurer was not in attendance.

Our president went over highlights from the Show Committee Meeting which was held today at 1:15 P.M. Those members who did not attend the meeting were given information regarding discussions from that meeting. The STOS Show at the Oakdale Mall is in the final stages of planning. Our three vendors will be housed with members who volunteered their homes and gracious hospitality. Each and every one of us thank you! There will be a dinner provided for the judges at P S Restaurant on Friday the 20th of April around 6:30 P.M. Any members who wish to attend, please feel welcome. (You will be expected to bear the expense for your own dinner.) As the time approaches, please let Luis Matienzo know so he can make reservations for those members who wish to attend.

Members were asked to think about changing the yearly dues for membership to STOS. We will ask for further input at our next meeting and vote. Please try to attend on April 15th. We need to finalize important issues for our show and we need your help. Time slots are still available for "manning" our information table at the show. Please volunteer to be a friendly face to represent our organization! We need you!

Anne called for a break in the meeting. At this time, raffle tickets were sold and we enjoyed the refreshments provided by our thoughtful members. Thank You!

The Show Table was next on the agenda. John Z, Dave C, Greta and Colin spoke about their treasures as we viewed their orchids.

The raffle was held and our business meeting ended to clear the floor for Ray Barkalow of FIRST RAYS ORCHIDS. Mr. Barkalow spent a few minutes apprising us of the background of his life which led him to being a "lover of orchids". Ray made us aware of the "life choices" which made him pursue an easier and better way of keeping his orchids, healthy and happy during his absences.

Ray told us that, generally speaking, all orchids are "hydroponic". His method provides flow regulation and root system health which allows for waste products to be expelled. Our presenter mentioned several times, for our benefit, that the best time to re-pot is when there is NEW roots showing. He asked: "What is Semi-hydroponics?" After explaining the process in helpful detail, we understood that water is NOT the cause of root rot. Rot is caused by too much fertilizer, gas exchange (suffocation) and poisoning from fungi and bacteria. Mr. Barkalow reminded us that virtually ALL orchids are suitable for semi-hydroponics. Mr. Barkalow concluded his presentation by asking if we had questions or comments. We applauded his program information and thanked him for his expertise. Our meeting ended at 3:45 P.M. Thanks to our members who stayed after the meeting to help restore the area to it's "pre meeting order"!
