Called to order by President Carol Bayles 2:00 PM

- Approved minutes of the last meeting in February 2022 as printed in the newsletter.
- Treasure report Jane Trey – Financial report presented. Amount not recorded in the minutes to avoid scams as experienced in the past.
- AOS Rep Bernice –
  - February and March AOS magazines are available for loan.
  - The AOS is celebrating their 100th anniversary, delayed because of the COVID pandemic, April 6<sup>th</sup> thru 9<sup>th</sup> with a gala celebration in Coral Gables Florida. Bernice mentioned several orchid shows available. And the STOS show is coming too.

Someone who can create and keep track of a schedule of manning the tables, setup and tear down, etc is desperately needed. I will help you get started.


### **Volunteers**
